Lynn Mack, originally from Ireland, grew up surrounded by forests, mountains, stunning European fabrics and interior design. In 2014 Lynn, husband and 3 children settled in Adelaide. Over the last few years she's been exploring her local conservation park and documenting the ancient pink rolling hills and walkways. Lyn loves playing with colour combinations she sees around her from the turquoise seas and skies, dusty pink rocks to the rich greens, ochres and navy blues of the coastal scrublands.

Lynn uses her favourite tiny brushes to paint with acrylic or oil paints on canvas to document the intricate patterns of grass seeds and native shrubs that she sees when getting out and about into nature with her family. She takes endless photographs then hoards bottles with grass cuttings, leaves and succulents for reference and inspiration for still life and landscape paintings at a later stage. Art has become a way for her to document her surroundings by painting and then sharing her discoveries of a stunning Adelaidean Landscape.

For our Social Night, Lynn will be showing images of her art, doing a demonstration and talking about her art background and process.


